- Noticing and discussing cognates and beginning to identify language detective strategies

# Knowledge:

- Learning phrases to describe the weather and vocabulary for the compass points.
- Counting from 1-100 in multiples of ten and combining this knowledge to make statements about what the temperature is.

### Enhancement

Record and broadcast a French weather forecast

- Using indefinite article in the plural form
- Making comparisons of word order in French and English
- Comparing shops and high streets of France and UK

# Knowledge:

- Learning food vocabulary and revising numbers to 100, this time in the context of money and prices.
- Developing language detective skills and confidence with practical conversational French.

# Enhancement

Open a French restaurant for teachers or parents.

- Learning and using some high frequency irregular verbs e.g. to have, to be, to go

# Knowledge:

 Identifying the infinitive form of verbs and subject pronouns, grouping French verbs and learning that there are regular and irregular verbs.
