Attendance

Our attendance for the last term remains below the Local Authority expectations – currently at 92%. Unfortunately, we have been overwhelmed holiday requests in term time and we fully understand why parents choose to do this, but we will have to process fines for holidays of 5 days and over, especially when it is a second holiday in term time within the school year. We ask that parents are truthful about school absence as untruths are challenging for the children to manage and I am sure all parents wish to be good role models for their children.

We will be sending out 52 attendance notification letters today to parents of children whos ateendance is at 90% or below. For your child's attendance to be at 90% they have been absent for 4 weeks in the last 7 months since September 2022. When a childs attendance falls this low all schools are directed to inform parents of this by the government.

Breakfast Club

This is now a popular provision and numbers vary daily which makes staffing a challenge. In order to avoid us turning people away please ensure you book your child's place through the school office email so that we can staff the provision safely. We can only accept children into the provision who are booked and have paid for the session in advance, the costs for this are: £3 per day and £1.50 for children who receive free school meals (pupil premium) into the provision.

We are pleased to inform you that Mrs McWilliams has now joined the breakfast club team.

Breakfast club will be closed on the last 2 days of term, Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th July. Apologies for any inconvenience caused.



After School Wraparound Care

The sessions are 3pm to 5.30pm and the cost is £25 for 4 days Monday to Thursday or £7 for a single session. The sessions *MUST* be booked one week in advance in order for us to staff the sessions in line with Safeguarding guidance. Bookings can only be made via the office email account, office@overdale.n-yorks.sch.uk. The class will not have more than 20 children in, with 2 staff members responsible for the provision and a senior teacher on site throughout.

Headteacher

School swimming Year 6

Our Year 6 children concluded their swimming programme this week. The class have been an excellent team to teach and have achieved great success, which we celebrated in assembly last Friday. National curriculum standard was achieved by 74% of the class and 33% of the class achieved the Mastery standard in swimming. Well done Year 6 – we are proud of your swimming successes.

Year 5

This class have only been swimming for 10 weeks have made outstanding progress, we will present 17 awards to them on the final day of this half term. We already have 37% of this class at National Curriculum standard and 17% of the class on track to achieve Mastery level by the end of the year. What a great start Year 5 –keep swimming!

Year 4

Mr Donald's class will begin school swimming provision on Monday 12th June, this will give them a 6-week starter plan in order to be assessed and grouped appropriately in preparation for their Year 5 swimming in September 2023. Details about the kit and costs will be communicated to Year 4 by letter and Dojo messages nearer the time.

Health and Safety

Sun protection

Please ensure you apply sun cream to your child's skin before school when the weather is hot and choose one that lasts for 8 hours. A hat is an excellent item of protection against sunstroke; please send one with your child every day during the summer term.

Safe parking

Please park safely and with consideration for our children's safety above parental convenience. Also, be aware that Jazz Court requires emergency access at all times due to the vulnerable nature of their residents. Overdale school parents do not have the right to use their car park as a school carpark. We provide 27 car parking spaces, thirteen in the lower car park and fifteen in upper car park beyond the barrier. No other school on the coast provides so many parking spaces

Cycles and Scooters

We are thrilled that many children have chosen to cycle / scoot to school, however school has a duty of care to ensure cycles and scooters are used safely to access school. All children coming to school on cycles must wear cycle helmets. Children on scooters are strongly advised to do so, but this will not be enforced.



Two year olds

We have applied to change the age range for the school from 3yrs to 11yrs to 2yrs to 11 yrs. This provision is now more likely to start in October 2023. The consultation is in progress and we will keep you informed of the outcome as we go forward.

Grapes

Whilst we welcome this 'healthy option' in packed lunches we are also conscious of the NHS guidance regarding this fruit. A grape is approximately the size of a small child's airway and they can cause chocking if not chewed sufficiently. The guidance recommends that grapes are cut in half from the stalk to the base of the grape to reduce the chances of chocking. We have a member of staff in the hall with every class, but that staff member is serving milk / water, cutting up food and opening packaging (packed lunches) they are not able to watch children on an individual basis. Please support us to abide by this guidance.

End of Year assessments

Early Years

These children will complete their 'Good Level of Development' assessments by the end of June and this result will appear on the Reception children's reports.

<u>Year 1</u>

These children will complete their Phonics Screening in the week beginning 12th June and the outcome from this will go out to parents with the child's report.

Year 2

The KS1 SATs have been completed, these will be used to guide teacher assessment for Y2 children and the results will be printed in your child's end of year report. Children who did not pass their phonics screen in Y1 will have the opportunity to re-take their phonics screen and again the result will be shared in your child's report.

Year 3, 4 and 5

These classes will all complete end of year assessments in June and these will support a teacher assessment that will be put on your child's end of year report. In June Y4 will take their multiplication test and again this will be shared with you on your child's end of year report.

Year 6

This class have completed their end of KS2 SATs with tremendous maturity and respectful conduct. The results will be in your child's report and they will be shared with the secondary school they have chosen to attend. Transition to Year 7 is now in action and the children will have the opportunity to visit their secondary school and for the teachers from there to visit Overdale school. In addition to this we have many planned opportunities for the children to make great memories of their final year at Overdale: Residential visit, Alpamare day, Y6 t-shirts, Y6 performances, and the final assembly.
