Holidays in term time

We will not be able to authorise holidays moved to the school year 2022 / 2023 due to covid. When a child is absent due to covid this will now be a part of their overall school absence. When you take a holiday in term time please ensure that you complete a holiday form so that we know your child is safe and we do not need to make a home visit to check this.

Breakfast club

This is now a popular provision and numbers vary daily which makes staff a challenge. Please ensure you book your child's place through the school office email by Friday at 2pm of the previous week, so that we staff the provision safely. In September we can only accept children into the provision who are booked into the provision.

Advanced notice

Breakfast club will be closed on the last day of term, Friday 2st October 2022. Apologies for any inconvenience caused.

Attendance

Our attendance to date is 92.58% and we look forward to improving this in the new school year. The Government is targeting school attendance for improvement alongside the drive for improved standards. Children cannot learn when they are not in school and their mental health also suffers as their peers move on and they are playing catch-up. The new attendance management is more rigorous and has more serious consequences for families.

After school provision

We are extending our Wrap Around Care (WAC club) in September due to parent demand. The sessions will now be 3pm to 5.30pm and the cost will £25 for 4 days Mon to Thu or £7 for a single session. The sessions need to be booked one week in advance so that we can staff the sessions in line with guidance. The class will not have more than 15 children in, with 2 staff responsible for the provision.

Time to say Goodbye

We say goodbye to Mrs Marshall on Friday, as she moves onto a new career pathway, we wish her well with this journey, but look forward to seeing her back in school as she will return to us for supply cover.

We will also be say goodbye to Mr Watson as he moves on to be a Headteacher at Skelton Primary School, and we know he will be a great Headteacher and we wish him success in his new role.

Miss Campbell is also moving into a new role as an ATA at Seamer and Irton School to support the children there.
