## **Welcome back**

The start to the second half term has been calm and settled, despite the first day being Halloween. A couple of requests from us:

Also please support your child to have PE kit in school every week, on the first day back we had several classes where PE kits were not brought in and some classes are still not fully compliant with PE kits.

Thank you to all those parent who bring children to school on time, collect them on time and ensure they have all the things they need for the day – we very much appreciate this.

# **Attendance**

A HUGE THANK YOU to the children who attended school every day in the first half term and to their parents for supporting them with this.

Our school is being challenged by the LA as our attendance for the first half term was well below the expected 96% at 92.56%. We will be sending letters to all parents where attendance has fallen below 93% for the first half term, this is a **legal requirement** for schools to inform parents when pupil attendance is below expectations.

We will be sending out 46 letters this week, this is a clear indication of why our school is being targeted for improved attendance by the LA.

The impact of poor school attendance and lateness in school cannot be underestimated.

Children fall behind with their learning, they become confused and disengage with the learning sequence due to missing sections of the learning plan and trying to catch up with the missed lessons. This then impacts on self-esteem and attitude to school life, it can also impact on friendship groups as regular absence does not make for good friendships.

# **Parent Consultation meetings**

This was a successful event overall and this was confirmed by the parent surveys completed, despite only receiving 32 responses from 168 attended appointments.

We received 9 parent comments – 8 were positive, THANK YOU. We received one negative response with several points within it. Going forward we would like to clarify the key points raised:

- Parent consultations are for teachers to talk to parents, not parents and their children.
- The children's workbooks are shared at the mid-year parent consultations not the start of year consultations. The first consultation is about how children have settled into their learning journey and how parents can support that at home.
- We are not able to host consultations in classrooms as this makes it impossible for us to safeguard staff, parents and children across such a large building. In response to this request we are considering inviting parents into classes at another time so that they can see their child's classroom.

#### **Library**

Our new school library is looking fantastic thanks to a generous donation from Lovell Later Living. They have kindly supplied the school with £1200 of funding towards our new Pie Corbett Reading Spine Books that the children in KS2 will be able to borrow from this week. We have chosen 6 school librarians who will be responsible for taking care of the area and ensuring all books are returned using our new library app.

A big thank you to the families that have donated books to school too – if you have any unwanted children's books at home we will gladly use them in our school library for KS2 or our 'Sharing a Story' book loan boxes in EYFS and KS1.

# **Allergens**

If your child has a food allergen, we will be contacting you to attend a meeting with Miss Campbell, and the catering services to review the food options and menu provisions we can offer in the new school. North Yorkshire County Caterers have reviewed their provision for children with allergies to ensure as many food options are made available to each child as is possible, our new kitchen supports this well.



#### **School meals**

We are pleased to say that our school kitchen is now fully staffed and we welcome Michelle Woolstencroft to our staff team. Our menu will now expand in the near future and we will keep you informed of the new options.

We would also like to remind parents that ALL children in Reception classes, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a <u>FREE</u> school meal under the <u>UNIVERSAL FREE SCHOOL MEALS</u> programme so please try some of the new options.

#### **Packed lunches**

Please may we remind you that items such as chocolate bars and sweets are not allowed in packed lunches. We offer water and milk to all children and strongly advise that children choose these drinking options in the dining hall.

#### **Christmas dinner**

NYCC catering will be funding a free
Christmas dinner for every child this year,
previously this has been funded by the
school budget, but this year this would not
have been possible due to budget
constraints. This meal will be served on
Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December.

# **School Funding Crisis**

This is now a very serious concern for all schools, as I am sure you will have seen in the media. Overdale school has benefitted from a balanced budget for the past decade and this has enabled us to provide many enrichment opportunities within our curriculum for free or at a reduced cost. Going forward we will not be able to do this until this situation is addressed at Government level.

The Government have made well deserved pay awards to teachers and learning support staff and they have not put the money to pay for the increments into school budgets, hence by 2023 - 80% of schools across the country will face a deficient budget.

Here are some of the **possible** impacts for Overdale:

- 1. After school clubs will have a charge, where they involve staff that are not contracted to Overdale: music / sports etc.
- 2. Before and after school care provision will have a costings review and this may mean changes to costs.
- 3. School trips / visits will not be free or subsidised, the first one of these is the Christmas Panto which has been **free for every child** at Overdale for 7 years (except in covid times).
- 4. School swimming the full cost of transport will be requested from parents and only non-swimmers / weak swimmers will attend.
- 5. Visitors into school will not happen Magic Mike / Diwali Dance etc.
- 6. Dojo Team rewards will have to be within school and not incur costs.

Schools are also being asked to consider:

- 1. Larger class sizes
- 2. Reduced learning support, this would include our highly successful Speech and Language provision, NURTURE teaching, and our SEMH (social emotional, mental health) provision.

We believe this would have a serious detrimental impact on our learners in school, at a time when we have worked tirelessly to recover from the negative effects due to the pandemic on learning progress and the emotional resilience.

The joint UNIONS for all the workforce in school are in discussions with the Government, to address this serious lack of funding for schools and we await the outcome of these discussions. Until such a time <u>no changes to staffing provision will be made at Overdale</u> and we very much hope that this will remain the case in the future.

We will keep you informed of any impacts that will directly affect Overdale school as we are informed of them.

# **In School Childcare Services**

Mon to Fri – Breakfast club – bookings only through the office email by <u>2pm</u> <u>Friday</u>; <u>office@overdale.n-yorks.sch.uk</u> This is £3.00 per day, and payments are needed weekly in advance. Payment reviews will be implemented in Jan 2023.

Mon to Thursday – WAC: (Wrap around care club) 3pm to 5.30pm. Book through the office email by 2pm Friday office@overdale.n-yorks.sch.uk Mon to Thu £25, or £7 per session. Payments must be made via Parentpay weekly in advance and not in arrears.



<u>Tues – Football Club</u> (KS1 –Year 1 & 2 ) 3.00pm to 4.10pm – This club is full, however we can add your child to the reserve list if you request a permission slip from the school office. There will be a charge for this club in Jan 2023.

Wed – Homework club (KS2 – Year's 3-6) 3.00pm – 4.00pm – please request a permission slip
