Attendance

The Government are targeting attendance in school this year as a way of raising learning standards after the Covid impacts on children's progress. This means that we will be sending out an increasing number of letters regarding your child's attendance. These letters will be sent out next half term to ensure parents are informed of their child's attendance and aware of the impacts this can have on a child's learning, especially when holidays in term time are taken year on year. We also know that many parents are surprised when the attendance letters arrive as they are not aware of how much time their child has missed. A loss of 10% in attendance equates to attending school for 9 days in every 2 week period. Late arrivals and collection also count towards attendance in school too so please ensure your child arrives and is collected on time. We fully understand that some children have been ill and hence the need to stay at home, and we appreciate that poorly children stay home to keep everyone else well. Last year a QUARTER of our children had attendance less than 90%, so our school is being supported to improve attendance this year.

A HUGE THANK YOU to the parents and children who attend school every day that is possible for them.

Parent Consultation meetings

Please book a slot to speak to your child's teacher on Tuesday 11th October 3.15pm to 5.30pm or Thursday 13th October 3.15pm to 5pm on the link that was sent via Text or call the school office if you have any difficulties.

Please enter school through the Hub entrance (green building to the left of the school office) and this will be the waiting area, parents will be called to the hall when the teacher they are seeing is free. Childcare will be in the library with Miss Quinn, children will go into the library through the main entrance to school and be collected after appointments again through the main office.



Fire in the community

We have been asked by the police to raise awareness of the dangers of children starting fires out in the community. In school, we will do this through assemblies and lessons in class. We will stress the danger to life and how this can get out of control even when we think everything is under control. We ask that you follow up this discussion with children at home if they play out on the estate.

PE

Please support your child to bring their kit into school every Monday and leave it in school until Friday, as this is an essential part of the curriculum which supports good health and wellbeing. Children will be given school PE kit if they forget their own, we know that many children do not like wearing school kits, to avoid this, please send in kits every week. If children are not taking part in the PE session due to medical reasons they will walk around the perimeter of the hall or the field to get their exercise and fresh air. If they are not allowed to do this for medical reason we will make provision for them to be learning in class during PE sessions and at break and lunchtimes.

Those with pierced ears are still required to bring in PE kit and change into it. These children will get their exercise and fresh air walking the perimeter of the playground or hall until they are able to remove their earrings.

School meals menu

We apologise for the variation to school meals provision as we are introducing our new menu. We have already discovered two meals that the children do not like and these have been taken off the menu. We will continue to review what is popular and what is not until we are back to a two week menu.



Allergens

If your child has a food allergen, we will be contacting you to attend a meeting with Miss Campbell, and the catering services to review the food options and menu provisions we can offer in the new school. North Yorkshire County Caterers have reviewed their provision for children with allergies to ensure as many food options are made available to each child as is possible, our new kitchen supports this well.

Drinks in school

All children have access to water throughout the day. At lunchtime we offer milk to ALL children alongside water. Packed lunches also have this option. If your child would like bring their own bottle for water that is fine. We strongly discourage juice at lunchtime – please support us with this to promote healthy lifestyles.
