Attendance

As always - a **HUGE THANK YOU** to the children who attend school every day since September and to their parents for supporting them with this.

It is a legal requirement for ALL schools to inform parents when pupil attendance is below the 90% attendance target. We sent out 46 letters at the start of the half term, and the attendance of those pupils will be reviewed again at the end of the term. The Department for Education has requested the school engage in a review of the PERSISTENT ABSENTEE pupils and progress these concerns through their systems and we have engaged with this plan.

The impact of poor school attendance and lateness in school cannot be underestimated, children fall behind with their learning, they become confused and disengage with the learning sequence due to missing sections of the learning plan and trying to catch up with the missed lessons. This then impacts on self-esteem and attitude to school life, it can also impact on friendship groups as regular absence does not make for good friendships.

School Events out of hours

Our EYFS hosted a Bonfire evening on Wednesday 2 Nov at 5pm, and this was a great success with pupils and parents. We hope to host more of these events going forward into the New Year for every class, as requested through our parent voice questionnaire.

We also hope to resume inviting parents to our celebration assemblies every Friday if their child is receiving an award, this will begin on Friday 20th January 2023. Dojo messages will be sent out on Thurs afternoon, we know this is short notice but they cannot be decided in any less time.

Safeguarding

On Friday last week our school received a SAFEGUARDING visit from the Schools Education Advisory Service. The advisor spoke to; children, parents and staff as well as checking polices, practices and routines around school. Under the heading of pupil voice the advisor reported that all children indicated that they felt safe in school.

The report also states that pupils represented themselves and the school extremely well. Pupils described the school as; fun, respectful, safe, the best school ever, inspiring, beautiful, awesome and welcoming.

The section under parent voice states that parents felt their children were safe and happy in school. A sample of the views expressed were: I can't fault the school, the school is great and they did a brilliant job in lockdown, the school deals with concerns immediately'. Christmas dinner

NYCC catering will be funding a free Christmas dinner for every child this year, previously this has been funded by the school budget, but this year this would not have been possible due to budget constraints. This meal will be served on Wednesday 14th December. Our thanks go to NYCC catering services for this kindness.

Breakfast Club changes - Term 2

We will have to make some changes to our breakfast club provision from January 2023. These changes are necessary due to reduced budget for schools and hence we can no longer fund this provision from school the budget. It must become financially viable if it is to continue and we **very much want the provision to continue.**

The following amendments will be put in place for January 2023.

Paid breakfast club = £3 daily, no change.

Pupil premium breakfast club = £1.50 daily, which is **half price**, previously free.

Pupil premium for services children breakfast club = £1.50, which is **half price**, previously free.

We do not want to make a profit from the Breakfast Club but we are no longer able to support the funding of this provision from the school budget.

However, any family in crisis can come and talk to us and we will do our best to support individual cases as best we are able to. We are lucky to have some parents who have offered to sponsor a breakfast for a child every week and this reflects the generous nature of many of our parents.

We know these charges have not come at a good time when the cost of living is rising for all households, but we are no longer able to make this essential provision without charging.

We look forward to your support with this necessary change.



After school football

The final session for KS1 children will be next week **Tuesday 6th December**, this session will be half outside and then come inside for the final half. The children have enjoyed the sessions and they will be offered another half term of sessions after Easter. In the New Year starting Tuesday 10th January the sessions will be for Y5 and Y6, after February half term the sessions will be offered to Y3 and y4.

School Funding Crisis Update

This continues to be a very serious concern for all schools but we are thrilled that the Government are going to put more money into schools across the next 2 years. However, there will still be a drastic shortfall going forward. Overdale school has benefitted from a balanced budget for the past decade and this has enabled us to provide many enrichment opportunities within our curriculum for free or at a reduced cost. Going forward we will not be able to do this until this situation is FULLY addressed at Government level.
