
Breakfast Club

We can only accept children into the provision who are booked and have paid for the session in advance: £3 per day and £1.50 for children who receive free school meals (pupil premium).

Staffing changes

Miss Kirby will be leaving us at the end of this Term to rest in preparation for the birth of her baby. Plans are being made to cover the class and make provision for the Key Stage 1 SAT's. These will be shared when they are finalised. We wish her well and look forward to welcoming her back in 2024.

Two year olds

We have applied to change the age range for the school from 3yrs to 11yrs to 2yrs to 11 yrs. This provision will hopefully start in September 2023. If you have a child at 2yrs in Sept 2023 and you would like them to have a place, please contact the school office and we will contact you when we have final details of the provision we may be able to offer. We will need to recruit staff who are trained in 'intimate care provision' to support this plan.



Children's University is back! Coast and Vale Community Action have taken over the very popular scheme that encourages our children to learn outside of the classroom. This week we had a visit from the Children's University lead, and she delivered an assembly on all things Children University. This is open to KS2 children and they have been asked to express their interest to their class teachers. They will then receive a pack that contains their login details and instructions on what to do next.

Lunchtimes

We will be operating a split provision for lunchtimes starting on Monday 23rd January. This has become necessary due to the increase in the number of pupils now attending the school, we can no longer all fit in the hall together. Some classes will go out to play **before** their lunch if they are not on the second sitting. We will amend our plan as we feel necessary when we have trialled the two sittings procedure. NEU Strike Action

The National Union of Teachers have advised their members to strike to support the requests for appropriate funding for schools. This is to enable them to make the necessary provision for all children in school and pay the teachers the appropriate wage for the highly challenging and professional role they hold.
