# February 2023 – Newsletter 6 'Respect, Responsibility, Resilience'

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Our attendance for the last half term was <u>93.74%</u> it has slightly improved from Term 1– keep it going up!

We received a visit from the North Yorkshire Authority to review our attendance practices and procedures.

The review had a successful outcome with the Advisor stating that the procedures were followed accurately by all staff, and the school prioritised attendance as an important factor that impacts on learning.

However, despite all that is being done, the school attendance is still below National attendance across the country.

Some children who are persistently absent were seen by the Advisor and they stated that they knew how important attending school every day is and only be absent when they were genuinely ill. The advisor was surprised to hear from the children that they took a day off for their birthday and that their parents approved of this, she informed them that this was not acceptable and that the school had to report this as an unauthorised absence.

Our updated attendance policy is on the school website for parents to view. The LA Attendance Officer will be in school on Thursday next week and direct the school to take legal action where attendance has fallen below expectations. Please understand that children whose attendance falls below 90% must now be passed to the Local Authority to manage. NYCC has directed all school who are below National scores for attendance to report this to the highest authority.



# Parents in school

The Year 6 children enjoyed having their parent visit the swimming pool to see them in their lesson. Thank you to all parents who made the journey, children and staff appreciated your presence. We hope to offer more events for parents to visit their child's classroom and see their children learning.

Parents of children receiving a Resilience certificate and trophy or a Respect certificate and trophy will be invited to attend our Friday morning CELEBRATION ASSEMBLY. Text messages will be sent out to parents by midday on Thurs to invite them to see their child receive their trophy and certificate and hear from their child's teacher – why they have been given the award. The EYFS classes will be sending out invites to parents to attend a 20 minute maths class after school on Wednesdays for this half term. We hope to see lots of parents attending these sessions. We can provide some 1:1 sessions for parents alongside their child to support learning at home if requested directly by parents.

### **Individual Progress Maps (IPM)**

Parents of children who have an IPM are required to attend a meeting about the learning support plan to share opportunities for school and home to work together to progress learning where it has fallen behind National expectations. These meetings will be requested directly by your child's class teacher before the end of term. These meeting are required to happen so the school is to meet the demands of the SEND code of practice.

We can only accept children into the provision who are booked and have paid for the session in advance: £3 per day and £1.50 for children who receive free school meals (pupil premium).
