Covid Update

We are back to a full staff team as we start 2022, which is excellent! This allows us to work more openly and not have bubbles in place. However, we are still limiting whole school gatherings. We will continue to observe the guidance as it is sent to us by North Yorkshire and the Government.

Presently we are:

Hand washing regularly, for children, staff and visitors into school.

Wearing masks in open areas around school and when going to the school gate at entry and exit times

Having key touch points and toilets cleaned at midday.

Working on 7 days isolation after virus infection

We thank you for supporting us with following the guidance when cases are identified to keep us all safe.

Going forward we hope to keep the school open as our number one priority. However, if staff becomes a challenge we will move to remote learning. This is not an option we want to consider and we would only do this if staff levels become so low that we are unable to Safeguard children. We have also been asked by North Yorkshire County Catering Services that if the staffing levels for school meal provision fall below manageable levels, they have a backup plan for 'pack up' meals to be sent to all schools. The meals are planned under the nutrition guidance that governs school meals, so they are a healthy provision. Again, this will only be actioned if absolutely necessary, and will inform you if we have to move to this option, but the notice may be short and this is beyond our control.



Staffing for January 2022

We have welcomed two new members of staff into school and one change of role for the start of 2022.

Miss Kirby is thrilled with our Year 2 children as they have worked hard, demonstrating respect for their new teacher.

Mr Donald is impressed with our Year 4 children, they have made him feel welcome and are keen to please him.

Mrs Davies will move into the role, Senior midday supervisor role at lunchtimes and our team of LSA's have moved around to support this change.



Items brought into school.

Please only send your child's reading folder and PE kit into school. We are asking that you do not send in party invites, birthday treats etc. as we do not want to compromise our covid guidance.

We would also like to alert you to an incident when Christmas cards were given out containing a sweet treat, children with allergies are not always able to have these treats and can eat them before adults are aware of the content, such action can have very serious consequences so please refrain from doing this. It is a lovely thought but can have devastating consequences. Thank you for your support with this.

Parent Parking

We continue to speak with the Highways Department to lay the planned access paths to school and to complete the traffic management outside the school. This process is slow. We continue to wait for a fence that we were promised by the LA last term, along the Community Hub path which would enable us to open the lower car park for parents at entrance and exit times.

As a school, we are considering the positioning of a barrier at the entrance of the staff car park that would section off 13 parking spaces and improve Safeguarding access to the school. This would be funded by the school, so it will need the full support of all stakeholders and we will be working on this throughout this term and keep you updated with our progress.



Swimming

The sessions for Y6 have moved to Monday mornings, leaving school at 9.15am and returning 11,15am approx. These sessions will start on Monday 17th January and run to the end of the year, covid permitting.

Y5

We hope to start taking Y5 swimming in Term 3. Parents will be sent an information sheet about their child's ability to swim in this term, to enable us to set groups. Please return the sheet with accurate information asap.



Wrap round care

We are considering opening a 'wrap around care' provision after school for working parents.

The provision would be Monday to and including Thursday's from 3pm to 5pm at a cost of £5 per session. We would be able to take a maximum of 12 children with staff team of two. Please contact the school office if you would be interested in the provision and if we have sufficient need for the provision we will action it after February half term.
