WELCOME BACK

Entry into school

KS1/KS2 - 08:40

The entry into school will remain the same. KS1 and KS2 Parents and children will wait down the side of the school building along the path and up to the green gate. Here, our SEMH and Health and Wellbeing lead Mrs McWilliams or a member of SLT will open the gate for the children and the classes, starting from year 6 and working backwards to year 3, will be called in. They will then make their way up to the playground and enter through their classroom door.

Children in key stage one will then be called in and the class teacher that they met on their transition days will be waiting for them at the end of the path. I understand that this may be a time that your child becomes upset after a long summer with their family, please be assured that we will support you to pass your child through the gate and we will do all we can to help them settle into their new classes.

EYFS -8.40am

Parents and children will walk through the Lower school gate, which is the one closest to 'Overdale' access to the estate. You will then walk to the gated entrance to the EYFS playground and walk through where you will be greeted by your class teachers Mrs Vasconcelos and Miss Wilson. Parents will then leave the school site by the same path.

11.45am

Parents of children who have attended Nursery for a morning session will receive their child from a member of the Nursery team at the Nursery School gate

Home time – 2.55pm

Reception and full time Nursery children will be collected by the parents who are asked to wait in the EYFS playground and listen for their child's name to be called so that they can collect.

Entry into school continued

KS1 Home time - 3.00pm

Key Stage 1 children will be handed out to their parents on the school playground. If your child is in year 1 or year 2, head up the path, accessed through the gate where children have been dropped off on a morning, and head up to the playground and stand outside your child's classroom. If you are unsure of where your child's class is, please wait on the playground and a member of SLT will be there to help you.

Key Stage 2

Home time - 3.05pm

Key Stage 2 children can leave school independently. Their teachers will walk them to the main gate and allow them to make their own way home or to their parent. Please use the letter sent out by the office to notify school if you are happy for your child to make their own way home.

Breakfast Club

7.50am

We will collect children attending Breakfast Club from the Main school gate, staff will lead them to the hall to be served and cared for until school starts.

Travel to school

I would encourage all parents and children to <u>walk to school</u> where possible. Where we are lucky to have a number of car parking spaces, these can soon be taken up.

Our neighbours are Jazz Court and they have a car park but it states that it is a PRIVATE CAR PARK and for the use of JAZZ COURT STAFF and RESIDENTS ONLY. Please observe these requests as we have a positive relationship with the staff there and wish to continue this into the future. Please do not park on the yellow lines on the turning circle. This prevents children crossing the road from seeing oncoming traffic. SLT will be available to keep our children safe and remind parents of our requests around parking.



Medicines

If your child uses an inhaler, they <u>MUST</u> bring it into school on Tuesday with them and you must complete an asthma form at the office. If your child has an epi pen or any other medical requirements, they will need to be in place for child to start school on Tuesday

Allergens in school

If your child has a food allergy and a meeting has not been conducted previously, we will be contacting you to attend a meeting with Mrs Campbell (Senco), and the catering services to review the food options and menu provisions we can offer in school. North Yorkshire County Caterers have reviewed their provision for children with allergies to ensure as many food options are made available to each child as is possible.

Staffing for September 2023

We are still hoping to see the number of pupils attending Overdale school in our two form entry classes grow, in order to allow us to fund having two teachers per year group. In the meantime we have created an EYFS unit and a split ½ class to ensure that adult to children ratios are adhered to and that we can continue to offer high levels of education and safeguarding to all pupils.

You asked, we listened


