Code of Conduct for Adults on School Sites

Purpose

This code is designed to give clear guidance on the standards of behavior all adults are expected to observe. The school will display this code on its school website and in the school entrance. It will be a key element of the school's induction programme for new parents, staff, governors and volunteers.

Setting an example

All adults who enter the school site at any time set examples of behaviour and conduct which can influence children and young people.

All adults must, therefore, demonstrate high standards of conduct in order to encourage our pupils to do the same. Wearing a Face mask is mandatory.

Expected behaviour

- Adults should respect all parents and carers, all children and all staff. There should be no physical abuse, rude or aggressive behaviour, bad language, racism or sexism directed towards parents, carers, pupils, members of staff or other adults.
- No adult should enter the school site under the influence of drink or drugs
- No adult should enter the school site with a dog or any other animal.
- Complaint should go through the correct channels. If a parent or carer has concerns about another parent/carer or child in the school, they must not approach them directly but should report their problem to the Headteacher - Mrs Logan
- Any personal matters that are not to do with the school should be dealt with off the school premises
- All adults should enter the school only through the main entrance or by permission from a member of staff
- Notes for teachers should be sent in with the child or given in to the school office by telephone
- The school has the authority to ban from the school site adults who repeatedly display unacceptable behaviour
